



DON'T LET YOUR HOME BE A GOLDMINE

Burglars are actively targeting houses which they believe contain jewellery and high value gold.

Follow these steps to help keep your home and jewellery safe:

- **Jewellery should be stored securely in a suitable safe. Various grades of safe are available according to the value, size and number of items you want to store in it.**
- **Safes should be supplied and fitted by a company approved by the Master Locksmiths Association.**
- **Take photos of your valuables and write a short description of each.**
- **Don't keep large amounts of cash in your home. Store it at a bank, building society or post office.**
- **Ensure all windows and doors are closed and locked before you go out and before you go to bed. Always use your alarm.**
- **Be aware of advertising an empty house, by posting messages on Facebook about dates and times of family weddings.**
- **Register all your property on www.immobilise.com, that way, if we recover your property, we can return it to you.**
