



Protecting your home

Take these simple steps to secure your home and help reduce the chance of being burgled.

- Keep doors locked and windows secure at all times
- Fit good quality locks to external doors and windows
- Keep keys out of sight and away from letterboxes and cat flaps
- Fit a security alarm
- Install tracking software on phones and computers
- Register your property at **www.immobilise.com**
- Keep fences and hedges well maintained, high at the rear and low at the front of your property
- Fit external dusk 'til dawn security lighting
- Make your house look occupied whilst away by using timer switches on your lights and radios
- Join, or set up, a local Neighbourhood Watch Scheme
